



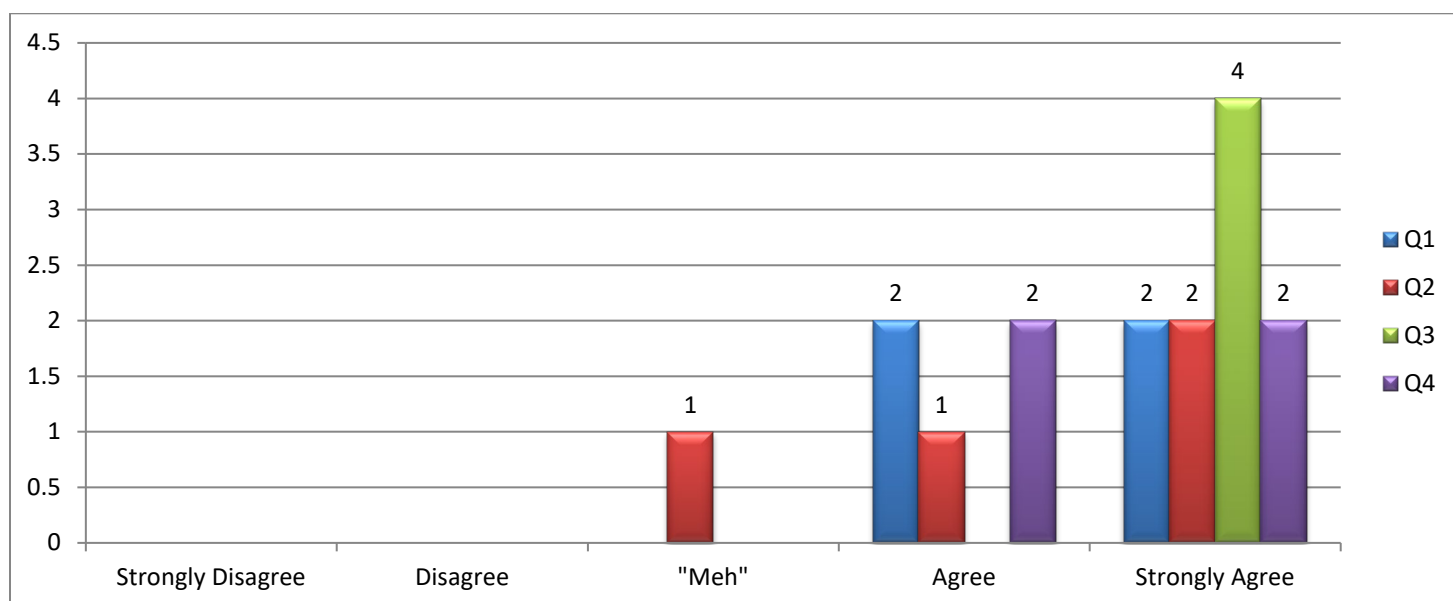
Tobin, UDL Champions Seminar
