

### Keynote


- 1. This session's information will be useful to me in my job.

Workshop 1: Re-Framing Universal Design for Learning (r=29)


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- As a new educator <6 mos this is a great way to include more interactive components to my class.

Workshop 2: Expand Learner Choices (r=29)


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- Also exactly what I was needing.
