



However, that is frustrating because the numbers are all over the place and are constantly changing. I can almost guarantee that next semester the numbers will be 8 and 4 or something else and then I will need to restructure my lesson plans again. I don't believe student learning is as limited as these sessions are making it out to be. And if students can only pay attention for the 4-6 minutes like the Using Canvas Videos to Improve Student Success suggested, and we really believe this, then we should never offer 1.25 to 6 hour classes again. When Waubonsee takes that kind of action, then I think this kind of presentation will have more weight and be deserving of our consideration.

Show compassion towards to students

Keeping in mind the many different ways a student might be experiencing a barrier to their education.

If faculty are NOT doing this yet, there is a big problem. If faculty are resistant to implementing these practices, the problem is bigger still.

I'm not sure, to be honest, as I already do universal design to some extent. More in-depth coverage of universal design would have been helpful.

I will continue to learn about UDL and will incorporate at least one accessible formats in my assignments.

I liked the way he gave us the option to have our cameras on if we want. I will incorporate this into my class. I felt I had to have them have their picture up all the time.

I feel like with the shift to online, I am already well versed in the +1 strategies that were discussed. I will work on further improving my videos.

I enjoyed the ideas and suggestions that were practical.


