

But now that it is all in one framework, it is much clearer and the benefits are much more obvious. I also like the fact that you asked us to prepare very simple projects, because otherwise most of us would tend to prepare a huge project that might not be feasible. So now at least we have a small project to start with. - Some suggestions - Google Classroom - This is the first time I have used Google Classroom. I think it is not as intuitive as other Google applications. I got lost a couple of times and could not find the materials. It always took me a bit of time to understand where the materials were and what I was supposed to do. As far as I could understand, I was not the only one. So providing instructions on how to use Google Classroom could be helpful, or simply stating that for those who have never used it before, it would be better to watch this video/document. - Length of sessions - I found them a bit short. I had so many more questions that we did not have time to discuss them. Especially the last session - I would like to have more time to understand my colleagues’ projects. - Applying UDL guidelines should be done in a way that we save our time and do not lower the requirements. - Additional information would be how to use apps/tools to manage the tasks we ask students to do. I know you do this in a very impressive way using Google Classroom. It would be interesting to follow up the projects.
