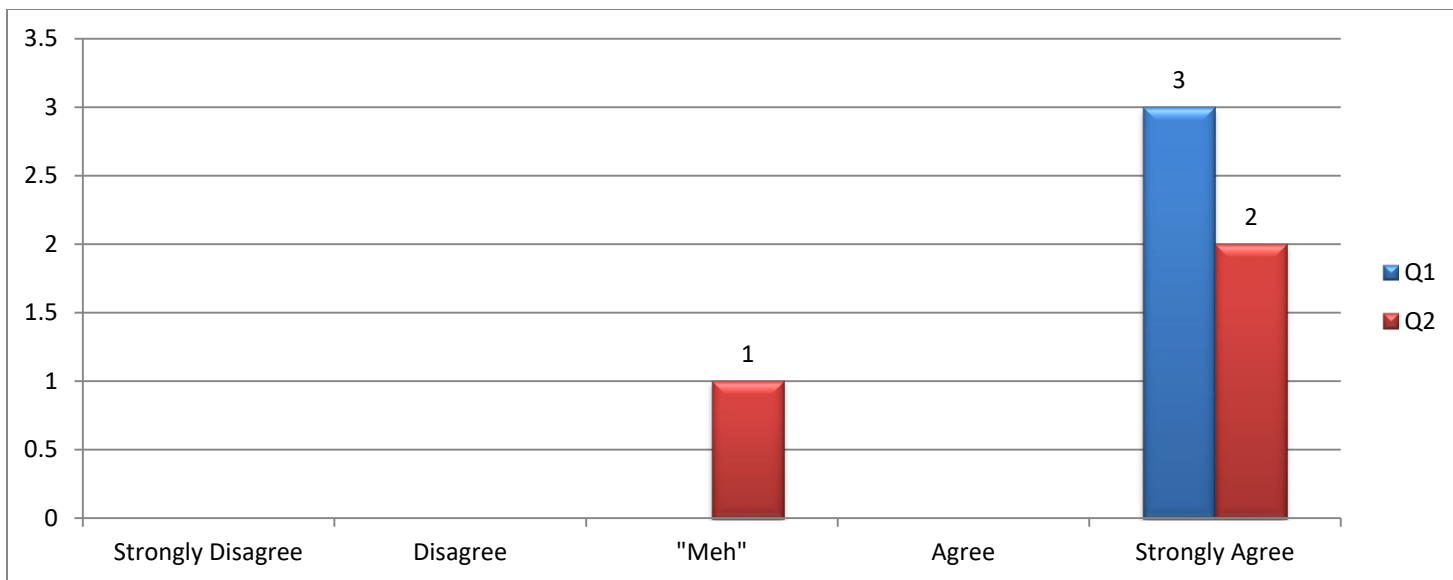




1. I found this session to be valuable to my personal and/or professional development.
