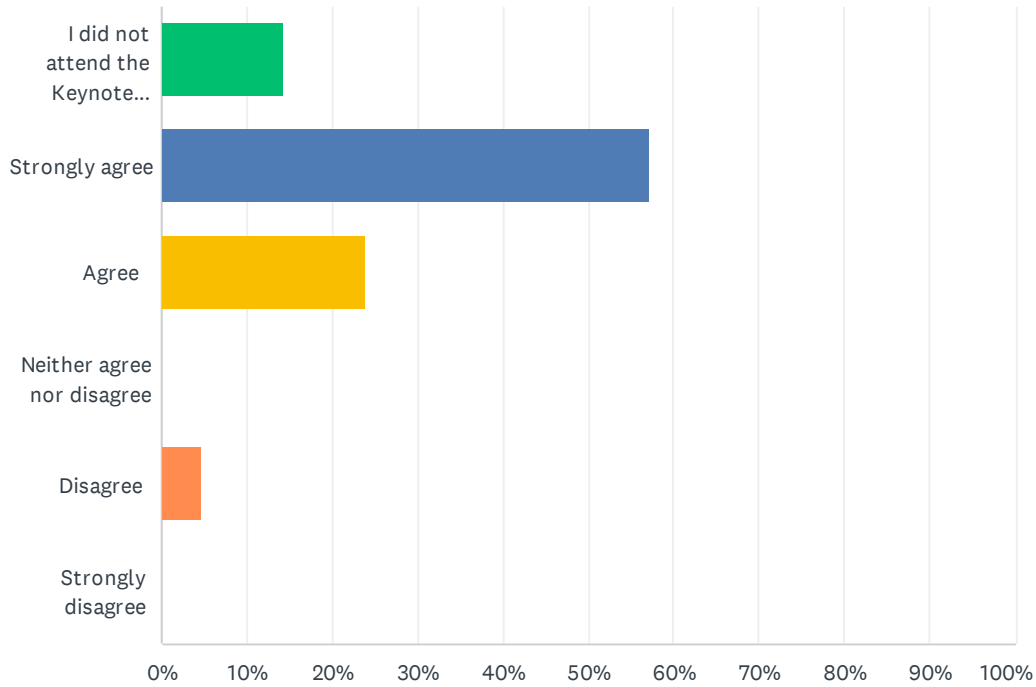


Q4 In the keynote session, I gained knowledge and/or strategies that will help improve my teaching.
